



Do you want to make a sound story?

Do you want to learn audio and multimedia skills?

We are recruiting participants for the project: Multisensory Storytelling: Creating Stories Through our Senses.

We are looking for participants who:

- Self-identify as disabled (e.g., developmentally disabled or neurodivergent);
- Are 18 years of age and older;
- Live in Calgary, AB and surrounding area or live in Victoria, BC and surrounding area

to take part in a multisensory storytelling session to create a sound story about disability pride and/or a life transition they have experienced.

Sound stories or soundscapes, are a way of recording sounds to reproduce the sensations of an experience. Participants can use sounds to create a soundscape up to 10 minutes long. No previous technological skills are needed.

The study includes up to six sessions over a two -month period. Each session is up to three hours long. Sessions will be offered online or blended (online and in-person) and take place between January 2023-August 2024, depending on enrollment.
